Dr. Corrie to present B2B opportunity in USA, Mexico, Canada and Brazil

Bruce Corrie Ph.D., Director – India Chamber of Commerce in USA, Dean - College of Business and Organizational Leadership & Professor of Economics, University of Concordia in Minneapolis, Minnesota is visiting India and will be in Mumbai on May 23, 2011.

Dr. Corrie worked with Governor Ventura on a state-wide report on the ethnic markets and with Governor Pawlenty on the potential of a trade mission to India. He has hosted listening sessions for Senators Wellstone and Coleman and US Small Business Administration, Strategies and vision for ethnic entrepreneurs adopted by the State of Minnesota and the City of Saint Paul.

He is presently Programme Committee at KFAI Radio, Board Member at African Economic development Solutions and Board Member at India Chamber of Commerce a US level Chamber with headquarters in Minnesota.

According to Seann Nelipinath, President and Director of India Chamber of Commerce, “this trip to India is about B2B (business-to-business) opportunity meetings” with tours to key cities that includes Mumbai, Delhi, Pune, Gujarat, Chennai, Cochin and Bangalore. He will be meeting with CEO’s and Industrial heads of manufacturing units, Educational heads, Medical device manufacturers and infrastructure groups and potential partners for entering into a partnership/joint ventures for business based primarily in USA, Mexico, Brazil and Canada.

His schedule includes meeting with Dr. Indu Shahani (ex. Sheriff of Mumbai) and the Minister of Industries in Maharashtra to talk about B2B Partner Cities with Minneapolis, St. Paul, Burnsville and Mumbai, Navi Mumbai, Pune.

He will also be presenting the opportunity to become a B2B partner in the upcoming Global Trade Summit 2011 in Minneapolis, Minnesota in August from 24-26.
